The room rate is \$94+tax Sunday through Thursday and \$103+tax Friday and Saturday. The rates are available two days before and after. 
Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, is just across the river from Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario (Canada). If you wish to explore the Canadian side of the river, you will need either a passport or an enhanced driver's license. Also, since the van rental agreement prohibits crossing into Canada, you will have to provide your own transportation. In the past, there has been bus service across the International Bridge but is not been back in service since the pandemic. I hope that we can get enough members to provide transportation to the Canadian Bushplane Heritage Centre for those who wish to do so. Sault Ste. Marie Municipal/ Sanderson Field (KANJ)

Commercial Airports

Chippewa County International (KCIU)

Flight Aware shows flights from Detroit and Minneapolis as well as several smaller Michigan airports. 22 miles/30 minutes from host hotel. The hotel will provide complimentary van service.

Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario (CYAM)

Flight Aware shows flights from two airports in Toronto, and one in Sudbury. 17 miles/36 minutes from the host hotel. International bus service may be available.

Saturday, July 22, Departure Day

All members are invited to fly their 170s (or whatever they fly) into member Jay Baeten's private strip, Antique Aerodrome (9WS2) in De Pere, Wisconsin, about 35 miles northeast of Oshkosh, to stage for AirVenture 2023, where we'll be celebrating the 75th anniversary of the introduction of the Cessna 170. Jay's strip isn't charted but is in most airport databases. It's located about 8 miles south of KGRB, about a mile west of the GRB ILS 36 localizer. Jay says he has room for at least 50 airplanes, and you can pitch a tent or lay a sleeping bag on the floor of his 90x45 hangar. Contact Jay (information in the Member Directory) and let him know you're coming. He says if he gets enough interest, he'll round up a crew to cook on site. Whether or not you're planning on stopping at Jay's place, please check the box on the registration form if you desire reserved parking for your 170 at AirVenture.

Tour Transportation

As has been the case for the last few conventions, charter busses have been cost-prohibitive, and we have relied on members making their private or rental vehicles available to supplement rental vans for longer-distance tour transportation. For this year's convention, we'd like to get an idea beforehand as to how many seats might be available, so if you can help out with transportation to the Pictured Rocks and Mackinac Island tours, please note on the registration form how many total seats you can make available.

Van Logistics

Since there are no vans in any rental fleets close to Sault Ste. Marie, I have reserved a 15-passenger van and a 12-passenger van here in Brighton, and a 12-passenger van in Lansing, all of which will need to be driven up to Sault Ste. Marie (about 5 hours). We need at least three drivers, but even accounting for luggage, I figure we can take as many as 20 people from Brighton to Sault Ste. Marie and back. To make this work, we would need for anyone doing this to come to Brighton, MI, on Friday, July 14 for an overnight stay, then drive/ride vans up to Sault Ste. Marie on Saturday, July 15. On the return trip we need to drive the vans back to Brighton on Saturday, July 22. This might be especially attractive to those who had been planning to fly commercially and would like to save on airfare by flying into Detroit instead of Chippewa County International. Karen and I can provide transportation between the Detroit airport and Brighton. In that case, it would be best to plan on flying into Detroit sometime on Friday, and departing no earlier than Sunday, July 23. If you can help with this, or have a better idea as to how to make it work, contact me.
